Moss (human?) wants to go to space but is already on a spaceship with illusions of being on Earth, so he only thinks he wants to go to space. Moss died on the illusions ship when it crashed into an asteroid. The asteroid traveled for a long time until it hit the green planet. The ship contains a communication device with a letter from Earth inviting the clouds to the Intergalactic Congress as an intelligent species, with transportation by UFO provided for them by the Invitation Committee. Moss has never seen this because the illusions kept him walking in circles in other parts of the ship. The simulation was caused by a prism shining ultraviolet light on Moss, who is actually a cloud. How did he end up like this? Earth abandoned him after changing their mind about the clouds, and erased records of Moss. Moss was never a human, but a cloud from a lab, so it was easy. It was already a

government coverup, but an upcoming short-notice inspection from the Intergalactic Congress prompted the higher-ups to destroy the evidence. The clouds were a long-ago Earth project from the 3000s millennium that the FBI only found recently, in the 4000s. Scientists reconstructed one cloud by the recipe: Moss.

The UV prism was a built-in mind-control remotely controlled by Earth. They started the illusions when they changed their mind. The prism was on the outside of the ship where Moss can't reach. Moss piloted the ship before the illusions started, avoiding asteroids.
